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Glossary

Amaro Averna

An Italian digestif, hailing from Sicily. Bitter orange, caramel and cola predominate, with a bitter gentian finish.

Amaro CioCiaro

A bittersweet Italian aperitif, with prominent flavours of cola, cloves, gentian and citrus.

Amontillado Sherry

A variety of fortified wine hailing from Jerez, Spain, produced from the Palamino grape which experiences both biological and oxidative forms of aging, combining savoury and slightly acidic flavours with richer, nutty notes.

Ancho Reyes

An ancho chilli-infused liqueur hailing from Mexico, originally created in 1927, combining fiery spice with smoky, earthy characteristics.

Aperol

An Italian aperitivo, slightly bitter with flavours of pink grapefruit and marmalade.

Bacardi Carta Blanca

A Puerto Rican white rum with light citrus and coconut flavours.

Balvenie Doublewood

A Speyside single malt whisky which enjoys a second maturation in sherry casks, producing flavours of rich stewed fruit and chocolate.

Biological Aging

A process employed in wine aging during which the contact between the wine, yeast, and surrounding environment induces the development of savoury, sour dough flavours coupled with light acidity.

Bulleit Rye

An American straight rye whiskey composed of over 95% rye, with flavours of rich oak, vanilla, honey and spice.

Bowmore 12

A medium peated Islay single malt whisky, with an emphasis on tropical fruit and smoke.

Café Borghetti

An Italian coffee liqueur produced from a blend of Arabica and Robusta coffee beans, featuring dark roasted coffee notes with a hint of mocha and smoke.

Campari

A bitter Italian aperitif, with flavours of blood orange, grapefruit and honey, and a long, bitter finish,

Glossary

Cinzano Bianco

An Italian aromatised wine, fragrant and delicately sweet.

Cocchi Rosa

An Italian aromatised wine containing saffron, vanilla and rose petals.

Cointreau

A dry French orange-flavoured liqueur.

Crème de Violette

A liqueur flavoured with violet flowers.

Cline Viognier

A Californian wine produced by Cline Cellars, with prominent flavours of peach and apricot.

Curacao

A cognac-based orange flavoured liqueur, with notes of candied orange and toasted wood.

Cynar

A bittersweet Italian aperitif, containing artichokes, which exhibits vegetal flavours coupled with caramel and toffee.

Elements of Islay

A blended malt containing whiskies from a handful of distilleries across Islay – heavily peated, with a light fruity backbone.

Genmaicha Tea

A Japanese brown rice green tea in which the rice is lightly roasted in order to “pop” it, introducing a slight popcorn flavour.

Glenfiddich 12

A light, Speyside single malt whisky with prominent flavours of pear and apple.

Havana 3

A light Cuban rum aged for three years. Citrusy, with notes of marzipan and allspice.

Havana 7

A rich Cuban rum, aged for seven years, with flavours of oak, vanilla and cream.

Hendricks

A floral and vegetal gin, produced in Scotland, with bright notes of cucumber, juniper, rose and vanilla.

Johnnie Walker Black Label

A blended whisky, with flavours of toffee, dried fruit and smoke.

Glossary

Illegal Mezcal

A Mexican agave-based spirit, produced in Oaxaca, where, unlike in tequila production, the heart of the agave plant known as the *pina* is roasted underground, producing a smoky, vegetal spirit.

Ketel One

A wheat vodka produced in the Netherlands, with a light mouthfeel and gentle flavours of citrus and honey.

Lapsang Souchong

A Chinese black tea which is smoke-dried over pinewood fires, imparting a distinctive, smoky taste.

London Dry

A style of gin characterised by its predominantly juniper led flavour and extremely low sugar content.

Malt

Cereal grains which have been dried in a process known as “malting” and encouraged to germinate, developing the enzymes contained within and converting the grain’s starches into more useful sugars.

Moniak Mead

An alcoholic beverage created by fermenting honey, produced in the Highlands of Scotland.

Noilly Prat

A dry French fortified and aromatised wine, produced with Picpoul de Pinet and Clairette grapes, then aged in oak casks which are left outside exposed to the elements.

Oloroso Sherry

A Spanish fortified wine, produced in Jerez from the Palamino grape, and which experiences predominately oxidative aging, causing it to darken in colour and producing a rich, nutty flavour.

Oxidative Aging

A process used in wine aging which deliberately introduces controlled amounts of air in order to oxidise the wine, imparting flavours of toffee, walnuts, fruit cake and marmalade.

Pâte de Fruit

A hard set, jelly-like confection.

Picon Amer

A French orange aperitif, containing gentian, quinquina and caramel.

Pineapple Champagne

A sparkling ingredient created in house by fermenting pineapples to produce tepache, then subsequently carbonating the mixture.

Glossary

Pineau des Charentes

A French aperitif produced in the département of Charente by blending grape must with cognac, producing a fruity, tart fortified wine.

Plymouth Gin

Formally referring to a style of gin produced only in Plymouth by a number of distilleries in the region, there now remains only a single distillery – Black Friars – which still produces this gin. Lighter and less juniper-forward than traditional London Dry gin.

Remy VSOP

A cognac produced by blending various eau de vies ranging in age from four to twelve years, with prominent flavours of peach, apricot, and vanilla.

Sake

A Japanese alcoholic beverage produced by fermenting rice which has been polished to remove the outer layer and provide the yeast with more access to the starches contained within, brewed in a process somewhat akin to beer.

Star of Bombay

A bolder expression of Bombay Sapphire, bottled at a higher strength, with bergamot and ambrette seeds supplementing the traditional Bombay botanicals.

St Germain

A French elderflower liqueur, with a bright, floral flavour. The liqueur is produced with flowers gathered from the hillsides of the French Alps during a short six-week period each spring.

Tanqueray,

An archetypal London Dry gin produced in Scotland, and originating in Bloomsbury, London. While the complete recipe is well guarded, juniper, coriander, angelica and liquorice root feature prominently.

Tapatio Blanco

A tequila which is rested for one month following distillation, exhibiting flavours of white pepper and green apple.

Tepache

A mildly alcoholic beverage - popular in Mexico - produced by fermenting pineapple, sweetened with brown sugar and seasoned with spices such as cinnamon.

Woodford Reserve

A small batch bourbon produced in Woodford County, Kentucky. Contains a relatively high percentage of rye, lending a light dry spice and oily mouthfeel to a rich, honeyed and oaky spirit.

Yuzu-shu

A style of sake produced by macerating yuzu – a zesty, sharp Asian citrus fruit – in Ginjo sake.
